Medicines

The school has responsibility for the safety and welfare of pupils and will regularly review arrangements to ensure that the medical needs of the pupils are met at school.

School staff will only administer medication which has been prescribed by a medical professional. Where over the counter medication (e.g. Calpol) is required this will only be administered according to agreed instruction for a specific period of time. Staff cannot make judgements regarding whether a child needs such medication. Staff will not administer supplements, herbal remedies or any other homeopathic medication.

All medication must be in the original bottle/packaging and be clearly marked with the child's name before being handed to the school office.

For those children with long term/ongoing medication (inhalers, Adrenaline Autoinjector pens etc) we only require this form to be completed once during their time at Oatlands School. We will however ask parents to review their child's requirements on an annual basis and expect them to complete a new form if the medication/dosage/method or timing changes.

Medication is stored in a locked cupboard in the school office. Inhalers and allergy related medication will be stored in the child's class room and/or in the Welfare room to ensure they are accessible.
