## Make a butterfly!

Our symbol for freedom is a butterfly. Try this simple butterfly craft to make your own.

Take a sheet of kitchen towel and fold it into quarters. Dip the corners into different colours of food colouring or use a cotton bud to add drops. Open out the towel and leave to dry before scrunching the middle together inside a peg. Use straws or pipe cleaners to attach feelers and stick to your window to let the light shine through.
